These people are vested in community and committed to helping the Black community of Duluth build and develop cultural resilience. The Board of Directors are selected based on their expressed and demonstrated commitment to the Family Freedom Center mission, their willingness to provide leadership and guidance to people involved in the Family Freedom Center programs, advocacy and opportunities that can support the Black community in Duluth.

The term of office for the Board of Directors is 2 years and a member may serve two terms. Board meetings are conducted quarterly on the first Saturday of each month at 5 PM-8PM at location to be announced. Please note that this is a working Board of Directors. (To be determined by the Board)
